Looking to cast people of all ages from 8-800 (in Dragon years ;)

Character Descriptions

Dragon (male presenting) – A friendly poetry-loving dragon who is initially mistaken for a monster by the villagers.

Charity – A young girl who is more interested in fairy tales than her daily chores and who finds a poetry-loving dragon in the woods.

Mom – Sassy and the boss.

Dad – A dreamer and a storyteller.

Mayor (female presenting) – Silly and naïve (some might say clueless 😊)

Jenkins* – Smart

Sam* – funny and sarcastic

Joe* – funny and sarcastic

Knight – Sir Nicole Du Wombat – A knight who is called upon by the villagers to slay the dragon.

Squire (male presenting)– The Knights sidekick

Scoop* – The reporter

The Village Militia Ensemble – includes the militia leader. Friendly yet loyal in defending their village. Cool dance moves are a plus!
